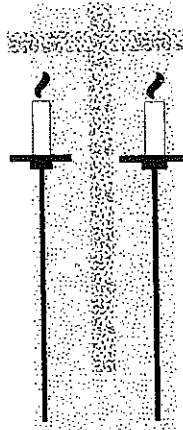

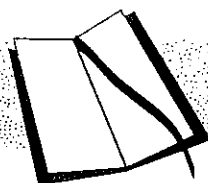
F.I.R.E. RETREAT FOR MEN

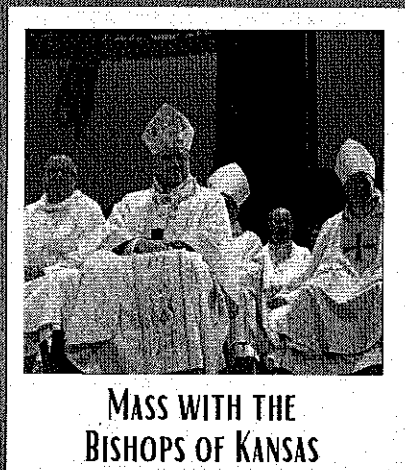

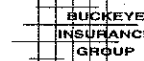
