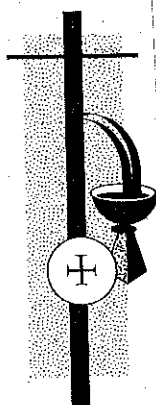

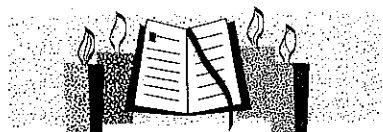

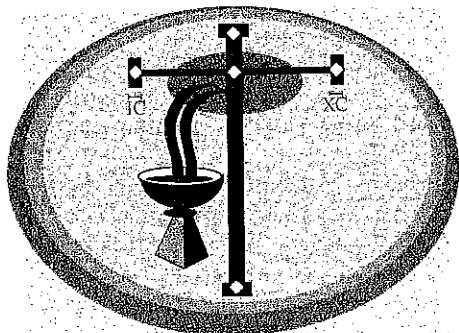
ARCHDIOCESAN HOLY DOOR AND SACRED JUBILEE SITES

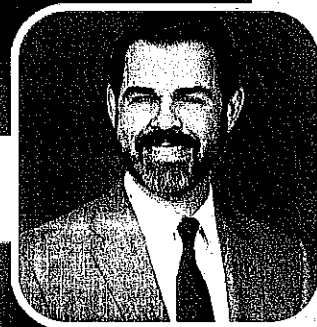

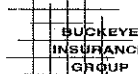
