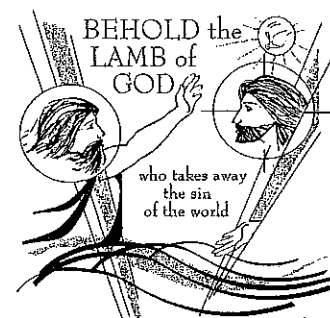
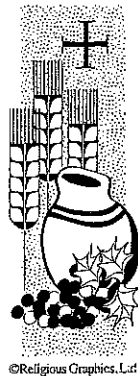

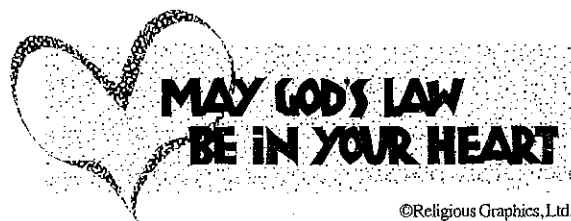

WHO WE ARE

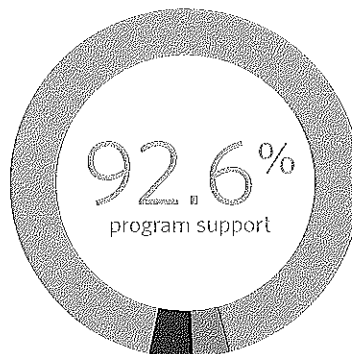

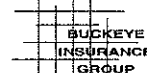
