Father Anthony's Corner:

Act of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

A special thanks to **Rosemary Pratt, Michael Stephan**, and Dave Hornung and nine additional parishioners present for the hour of Prayer, Exposition, Adoration, Consecration, and Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament this past Friday morning. This is a special time in the history of our world and planet! Thank you!

Synodal Consultation Sessions: On behalf of Sacred Heart Catholic Parish, I extend our deepest thanks and will do so again to Bob Bezek, who gave generously of his time to coordinate our three synodal consultation sessions. In a brief conversation, Bob shared with me how the sessions have energized who parishioners expressed renewed hope and their desire to connect with Sacred Heart Catholic Parish in a way that fosters their Catholic faith and what it means to a parishioner of Sacred Heart Catholic Parish.

As pastor, I think these sessions have been a great success, and I believe they took place for all of us at a time when the outcome of dialogue and expectations will be most beneficial to our parish mission: "Give Glory to God," "Show Compassion to our Neighbor," "Take up your Cross," and "Follow the Sacred Heart of Jesus."

Lay Ecclesial Ministry Formation: Archbishop Naumann – "I am happy to announce that we have partnered with Franciscan University of Steubenville's Catechetical Institute (CI) to provide: i) non-degree, ii) field-level, iii) on-line supported, iv) multi-dimensional ministry formation.

The launch of this partnership over the next several months will include multiple CI Formation and Explanation Events directed toward lay leaders and offered both in live webinar formats and in-person meetings. Three objectives will be achieved through these events:

1. Participants will **strengthen communion** within a diocese and with the Church Universal through the a) local, b) mentored, c) substantive, and d) engaging CI Approach to formation.
2. Participants will **gain competence** in using <https://franciscanathome.com/>, a user-friendly, mobile-scalable, proprietary learning management system, where, presently, over 170 true video workshops in English and in Spanish from over 50 different catechetical experts from throughout the world organized

50 different catechetical experts from throughout the world organized into 14 ministry tracks are provided with unlimited access to anyone in a subscribing institution.

3. Participants will **build confidence** as Catholic mentors who make a three-fold gift of themselves to other disciples through a) accompaniment, b) encouragement, and c) gentle accountability.

Please save the date – lay leader training will be held May 5th and May 7th. These identical trainings require attendance by lay leaders at only one session. More details will be forthcoming.”

Dress for the Assembly at Mass: Members in the assembly proclaim the living presence of Christ - both verbally and nonverbally. The central focus of the mass is the sacred presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Please consider dressing simply, appropriately, and modestly out of reverence and respect for God.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Grant: The Archdiocese a Catechesis of the Good Shepherd grant with funds available to all Archdiocesan parishes. The purpose of the CGS Grant is to offer a source of financial support to those within the Archdiocese who are trying to obtain catechist training, open a CGS atrium, or maintain their current atria. There will be two review periods this fiscal year. Applications for assistance (with supporting paperwork) will be due by April 1st and June 1st. If interested, please see **Rosemary Pratt**. 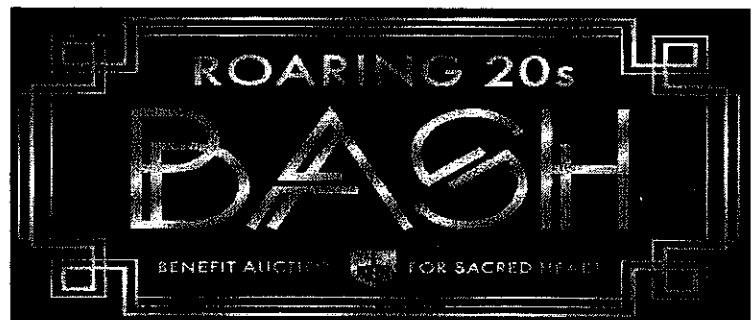
