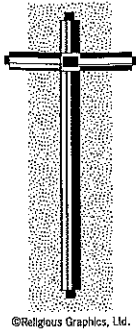

Catholicism explained:

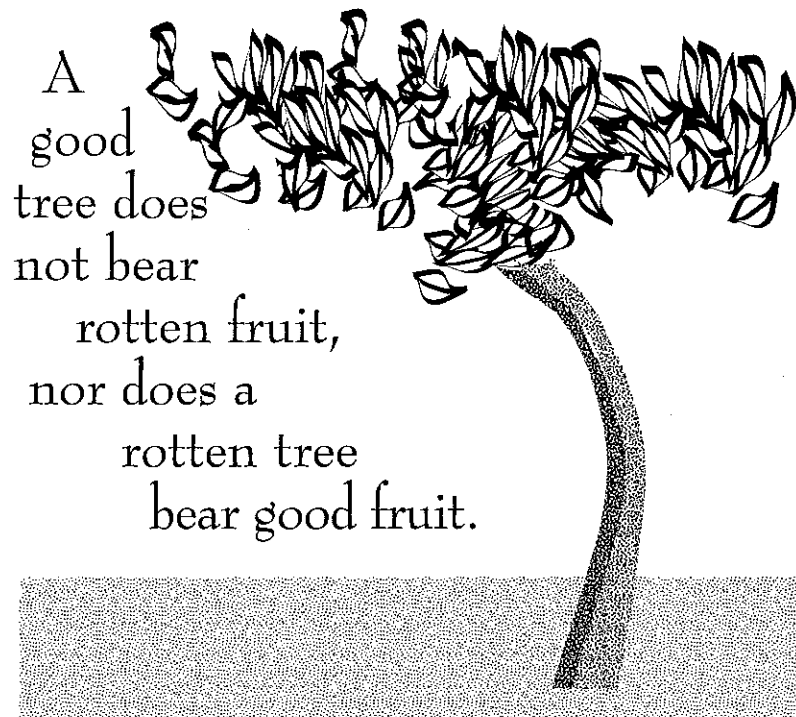
What is an Indulgence? An indulgence is the remission of temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven (generally in the Sacrament of confession) granted by the Church. Mortal sin deprives us of eternal life with God. This is called eternal punishment or hell. Venial sin involves a lessening of our love for God and deprives us of life with Him for a certain period of time, and this is called purgatory. When mortal sins are forgiven there is the remission of the eternal punishment of sin. Temporary punishment remains. This entails a purification of soul, either here on earth or after death in the state called purgatory.

The takeaway and bottom line for me is this: mortal sins must first be forgiven in the sacrament of confession in order for the purification of the soul in purgatory.

Synodal Consultation Process: Bob Bezek has enjoyed meeting several parishioners and explaining the Synodal Consultation Process, which was initiated by our Holy Father, Pope Francis. The three meeting times invite our parish to share with honesty, sincerity, and a vision about our Catholic faith and expectations. I humbly ask that you accept Bob's invitation to participate in this process.

Mt. Calvary Catholic Cemetery Board: The new members of this board are Mike Kuban, Parker Olmsted, Alan Bina, and Pastor (Fr. Anthony). I especially extend my thanks to Mike, Parker, and Alan for a very successful first cemetery board meeting, held on February 18, 2022.

Surcharge Information: The winter storm in February 2021 caused natural gas prices to soar. Thus, an electric surcharge was added to customer utility bills in April 2021 and will continue through April 2023. Please turn off lights when leaving the school and thermostat controls will be adjusted to use only what is needed so that energy is not wasted.

- 1) **Servers** are responsible for lighting all candles in the sanctuary.
- 2) Genuflect on right knee before entering sanctuary.
- 3) Bells are not rung during Lent.
- 4) Servers process in and out with the crucifix.
- 5) Please hold the Roman Missal for opening and closing prayer.
- 6) Place the ciborium and chalice on the altar and offer wine and water for offertory.
- 7) Assist Father with the purification of hands with water.
- 8) Extinguish all sanctuary candles
- 9) Incense will be used on Holy Thursday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday.

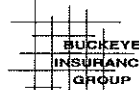
