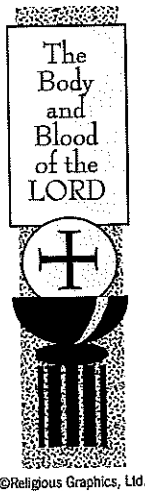

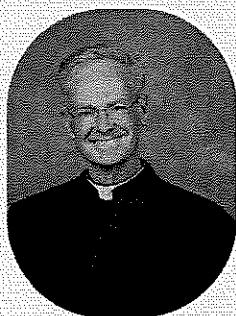

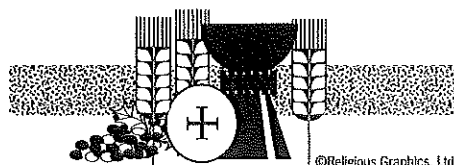
### CHURCH CLEANING WEEK

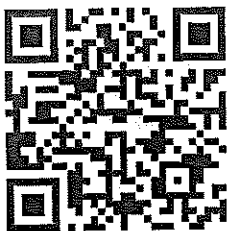

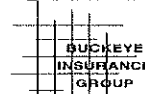
