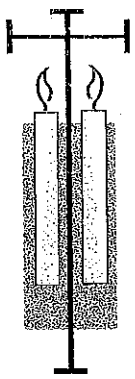

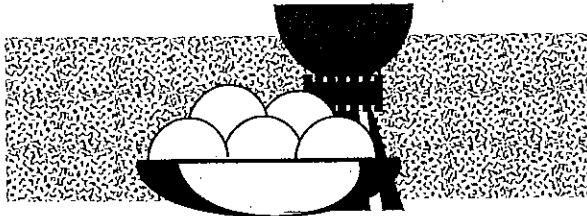

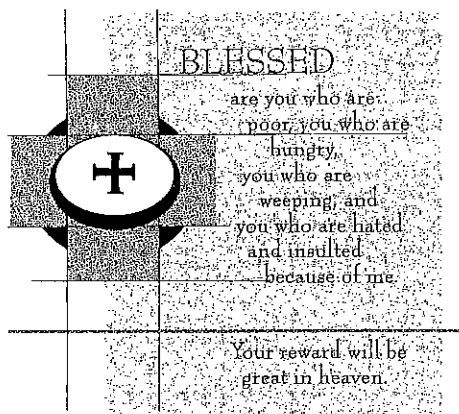

MAGNIFY RETREAT FOR WOMEN 3/29/25

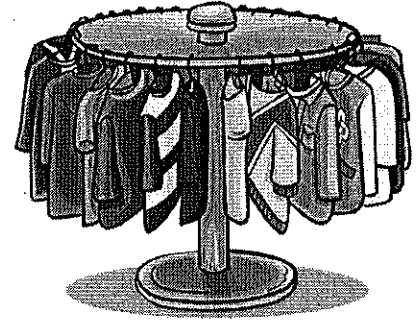
