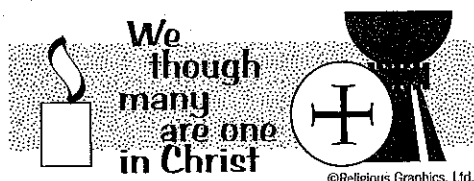

## **Father Anthony's Comments:**

**Fasting before receiving Holy Communion:** "One who is to receive the Most Holy Eucharist is to abstain from any food or drink, with the exception only of water and medicine, for at least the period of one hour before Holy Communion.

"Those who are advanced in age or who suffer from any infirmity, as well as those who take care of them, can receive the Most Holy Eucharist even if they have taken something during the previous hour" (Code of Canon Law 919).

**Penance:** February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 1:00 PM in Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Parents of students who are preparing for their "First Penance" are asked to meet on February 5<sup>th</sup> and the time TBD.

**Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:** February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 the Blessed Sacrament exposed on the main altar following mass, instead of in the Adoration Chapel that day. Grade school students will be in the church for "adoration" at 2:00 PM that Thursday, as part of spiritual formation during Catholic Schools Week.

**Mass attendance and support for Ministries:** The Pastoral Advisory Council has begun to evaluate the low attendance at the Saturday 5:30 P.M. and Sunday 11:00 A.M. masses. ### Financial Notes

Archdiocese Capital Campaign "One Faith" Rebate: **\$8,844.00**. Parishioners contributed **\$123,705** to the Archbishop's Campaign.

**Improvement Projects:** 29 Windows in the rectory were replaced for **\$17,000**. Exterior openings in school building were inspected and sealed to prevent entry for nearly **\$4,200**. Sacred Heart School Hallway ceiling replacement completed for **\$19,200**, and Sacred Heart School Painting completed for **\$8,700**. Replaced school and rectory AT&T phone system with the new AVID system with a bridge to the school with two-line numbers for each administrative office. With the upgrade to **Vyve internet** projected costs savings average nearly **\$400** per month. Transitioned software system to the Breeze

program to enable weekly on-line electronic debiting for offertory collections and the main database for parishioners. Sacred Heart Parish received a Paycheck Protection Program in the amount of **\$111,000**. This loan was forgiven through the Cares Act and was for the purpose of retaining employees and their benefits throughout the Covid pandemic. The full cost for installing the electronic equipment on the front entrance door to the school was donated by an anonymous parishioner.

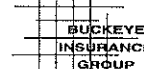
