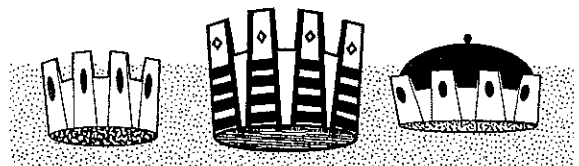

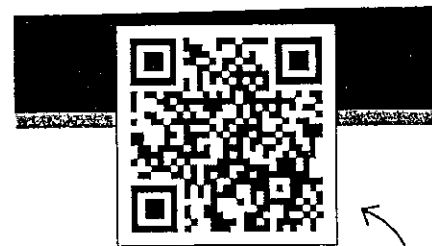

VIRTUS TRAINING WORKSHOP **PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN**

Sacred Heart Church will sponsor a VIRTUS Awareness Session for adults of our parish on January 14, 2023 (Saturday) from 9:00 am – 12:00 noon at the Parish Center. VIRTUS is our archdiocesan program for preventing children from unsafe situations. All adults (employees/ volunteers/ parents/ guardians) who interact with or around children (whether it be to teach, volunteer in classrooms, chaperone/ drive on fieldtrips) are required to attend so as not to be unable to help if and when the time comes. If you think that you may want to help out with children in our parish over the next few years, please plan to attend. Please take this opportunity to attend the training now since it will be held at our very own Parish Center. Virtus Training Workshops held at other locations throughout the year are most often scheduled in the evenings.

Please take note that if you are under 18 years of age, a parent/ guardian must attend the session with you or complete a parental permission form. 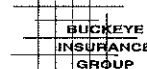

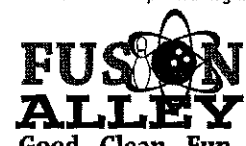
