VALUE THEM BOTH ANNOUNCEMENT

Pray for Overland Park Parish Vandalized for Value Them Both Support. An escalating pattern of theft, vandalism and intimidation targeting members of the Catholic Church and other supporters of the Value Them Both amendment reached a new level recently when the Church of the Ascension in Overland Park fell victim to vandalism. Parish buildings, including a statue of the Blessed Mother, were extensively defaced with red spray paint. Authorities were notified and asked that every action be taken to identify and hold the perpetrator of this act accountable.

“This attack and others targeting Catholic Churches across the country are un-American. The intention is clearly meant to intimidate and threaten the Church's pro-life beliefs and position of support for the Value Them Both amendment. We will not be deterred. The Catholic Church remains firm in its support of mothers and preborn babies and our members are more dedicated to our mission than ever before.” ~ Archbishop Joseph Naumann

We ask for prayers for the Church of the Ascension's parish community, for civility leading up to the Aug. 2 vote, and for those committing these acts of vandalism.

What does the Value Them Both Amendment do?

Value Them Both is a reasonable, common sense response to the extreme 2019 ruling by the Kansas Supreme Court that cleared the path for unlimited abortions in our state. It protects life-saving limits on the abortion industry. It restores the ability of Kansans to enact laws through their elected representatives, just as we have done for the past 25 years.

Does Value Them Both Ban abortion?

No. The only thing it bans is taxpayer funded abortion.

Why is VTB even needed with *Roe* being overturned?

The decision to overturn *Roe v. Wade* simply returns the question of abortion to each state.

In 2019, the Kansas State Supreme Court declared that abortion is an unlimited right. Every limit on abortion, in the words of the Court, is now “presumed unconstitutional.” Abortion limits and laws are already being struck down, one-by-one. The result is that Kansas is becoming a destination for extreme abortions.

That’s why passing Value Them Both—a state constitutional amendment that reverses the 2019 ruling—is more crucial than ever before.

Since 2019, abortions have increased by 13% and half of our abortions are performed on out-of-state residents coming to Kansas.

The abortion industry would like nothing more than to keep abortion unlimited and unregulated in Kansas. It wants Kansas to become a destination state for extreme abortions, even up to the moment of birth, paid for with tax dollars.

Does Value Them Both impact ectopic pregnancies, miscarriages, etc...

No. Anti-amendment forces want to make this campaign about anything but painful late-term abortions and keeping limits in place on the Kansas abortion industry. Medical treatments for ectopic pregnancies, miscarriages and other pregnancy complications are not the same as an abortion.

Kansas has a very clear legal definition of abortion-K.S.A. 65-6701(a).

- The treatment for an ectopic pregnancy is NOT an abortion.
- The treatment for miscarriage is NOT an abortion.
- The treatment for septic uterus is NOT an abortion.

Does Value Them Both have anything to do with contraception?

No. Value Them Both has nothing to do with contraception. The wording of the amendment clearly states that this restores the people's voice in matters specific to abortion.

What about women facing potential life-threatening situations from a pregnancy?

Mainstream media outlets and legal scholars have continually confirmed that the Value Them Both Amendment does not ban abortion and every Kansas law limiting abortion has exceptions to save the life of the mother. In addition, many reputable physicians who treat high-risk and traumatic pregnancies will say that an abortion is not medically necessary to save the life of the mother.

What about cases of rape and incest?

Rape and incest are horrific violence against women and the Church and pro-life community must surround any woman harmed in this way with love, prayer and support. Legal scholars have continually confirmed that the Value Them Both Amendment does not ban abortion. However, contrary to what pro-abortion forces want us to believe, not every woman in this situation wants an abortion. Value Them Both will safeguard laws that will help protect these women from being further harmed by the abortion industry.

Does Value Them Both create any new laws?

No. Value Them Both is a state constitutional amendment. It does not create any new laws. It will however protect existing commonsense and broadly supported laws regarding abortion that Kansas has enacted over the past 25 years. Does Value Them Both give new or additional power to our Legislators?

No. Value Them Both simply restores our state Constitution to the way it was before the Kansas Supreme Court decision in 2019. It takes control of abortion policy away from unelected judges and puts it back in the hands of Kansans to enact laws through their elected representatives, just as we have done for the past 25 years.

Why is the verbiage of the Amendment worded how it is?

The language of the amendment is carefully drafted legal language that was created to specifically address the 2019 Kansas Supreme Court ruling. Kansans can find the complete wording at ValueThemBoth.com. The pro-life vote is the YES vote.

The opposition claims that abortion is already heavily regulated in Kansas. Is this true?

Because of a radical 2019 Kansas Supreme Court ruling, every limit on the abortion industry is presumed unconstitutional and our laws limiting live dismemberment abortions and requiring abortion clinic inspection and sanitation standards have already been struck down. If Value Them Both does not pass, virtually all laws regulating the abortion industry will fall and the Kansas City Star has reported we could see a 1000% increase in abortions in our state. Value Them Both will keep Kansas from becoming a permanent destination for abortions.

Who Supports the Value Them Both Amendment?

The Value Them Both Coalition is made up of Kansas citizens and groups who believe every human life has value. We are led by Kansas Catholic Conference, Kansans for Life, and Kansas Family Voice. We welcome the support of all individuals and organizations who hold this goal.

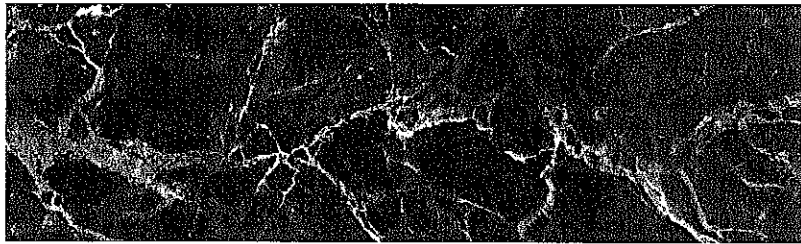
