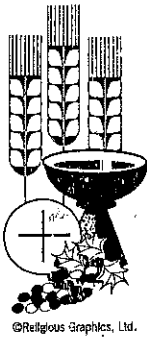

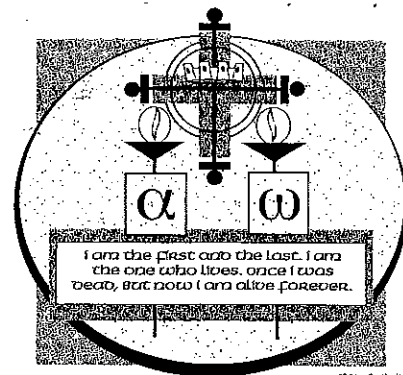

Father Anthony's Corner:

Easter Masses: A special thank you to all who donated flowers for our altar and sanctuary this Easter Season. The awesome choice of flowers selected add beauty to the solemnity of our sacramental celebrations. Thank you!

Paschal Candle: Replaces the Processional Crucifix and remains in the sanctuary throughout the Easter Season. It is removed and brought to the baptismal font near the entrance to the main body of the church following Pentecost Sunday.

Divine Mercy Sunday (Second Sunday of Easter): Special thanks to Rosemary Pratt for the 200 flyers explaining the significance of Divine Mercy Sunday.

Father Anthony will be available for the sacrament of confession at 10:15 a.m. and 12:15 p.m., on April 24th (Sunday).

“In the Sacrament of Baptism not only is the guilt of sin remitted, but also all the penalties attached to sin. In the Sacrament of Penance the guilt of sin is removed, and with it the eternal punishment due to mortal sin; but there still remains the temporal punishment required by Divine justice, and this requirement must be fulfilled either in the present life or in the world to come, i.e., in Purgatory. An indulgence offers the penitent sinner the means of discharging this debt during his life on earth” (Newadvent.org)

An indulgence is “the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sin whose guilt has already been forgiven. A properly disposed member of the Christian faithful can obtain an indulgence under prescribed conditions” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1471).

- Participation in the "prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy" in a church or chapel while "completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin", or recitation of the Our Father and the Creed in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, adding the prayer "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you"
- Sacramental confession
- Holy Communion
- Prayer for the intentions of the pope

With a justifiable reason if you are unable to go to a church or chapel you may obtain an indulgence with the recitation of the Our Father and Creed before an

image of Jesus, adding the prayer "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you", with the conditions of detachment of sin, and the intention to fulfill the dispositions above as soon as possible.

Altar Servers: Thanks so much for your willingness to continue to serve at the altar. Please remember to always wear a mask when serving and sanitize hands before, during, and after mass. I will do the same. Thank you!
