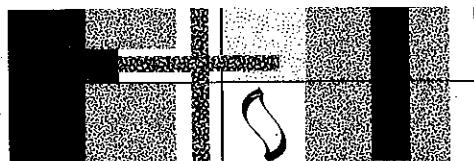
HELPING KANSAS WOMEN WEBSITE

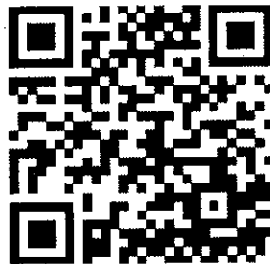

What is the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd?

Beginning in 1954, in Rome, Italy, Sofia Cavalletti and her colleague, Montessorian Gianna Gobbi, developed an approach to faith formation that not only appealed to the profound religious intuition of younger and older children, but also evolved from the children themselves.

Focusing on God's unconditional love through the parable of the Good Shepherd, the Level I catechist formation is based on the conviction that God and the child are in relationship. It is the foundation for the Catechesis in general and for the 3- to 6-year-old child in particular.

The Level I course, comprising two parts, will give you the background formation as well as the skills to create a prepared environment (an atrium) and to offer presentations that enable the child to draw nearer to God. A bonus is that adults draw nearer to God as well.

A prerequisite for registering for Part 2 is completion of the first part of Level I formation.

The United States Association of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd was formed in 1984 with its purpose as "involving adults and children in a common religious experience in which the religious values of childhood are predominate." It's an invaluable resource for networking, publications, materials, and more.

The SonFlower Region of CGS incorporated in 2008 and serves catechists and atria in northeastern Kansas and northwestern Missouri. With no dues, anyone enrolled in a SonFlower course is added to its membership.

REGISTRATION

Please register for courses online at the SonFlower Region website: www.cgsksmo.org/courses. Registration is complete when the \$100 deposit is paid. The deposit and the balance of your tuition may be paid by credit card online, or you may choose to give cash or checks to the course registrar. Make checks payable to SonFlower Region of CGS (memo the course/part number).

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Formation of a catechist requires a commitment of money as well as time, and you are encouraged to seek financial assistance when necessary. Do not let money stand in the way of your formation.

Financial assistance is available through various sources. Check with your parish, school, or atrium. Members of the U.S. Association may apply at www.cgsusa.org/learn/courses-for-adults/scholarship-grant-information/. Residents of the Archdiocese of Kansas City, Kan. may apply through its Office of Children's Catechesis, www.archkck.org. Or apply through the SonFlower Region at CGSKsMo.org.

Include a copy of this flier and your registration confirmation with any aid application. Carefully note strict application due dates, often six or more weeks ahead of the course start date.

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd seeks to help adults open their eyes to the hidden riches of the child, especially to the child's spiritual wealth, so that adults will be drawn to learn from the child and to serve the child.

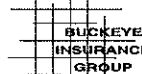
